- Depart the U.S. for Johannesburg, South Africa. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel in the suburb or Rosebank. Visit the Soweto district, where you see the homes of Nelson Mandela and Archbishop Desmond Tutu. Tour the moving Hector Pieterse Museum and hear fascinating stories from a local Sowetan.
- Fly to Zambia and transfer to your deluxe lodge in the Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve. See this thundering natural wonder and embark on a game drive to spot the elusive black rhino. Embark on a "Sundowner" Zambezi dinner cruise. Encounter life at a local village and enjoy leisure time at your lodge.
- Visit a nearby school then travel to Botswana's Chobe National Park, boasting one of Africa's largest concentrations of wildlife. Enjoy multiple wildlife drives and boat safaris offering an up-close look at Chobe's exceptional array of wildlife – including the world's largest elephant population, along with zebra, lion, giraffe, impala, wildebeest, and buffalo.
