Visit modern cities and rural villages standing on stilts in watery basins. This is the home of ancient traditions that have survived the encroachments of colonialism and modern life. Here you will uncover the secrets of ritual masks, talk to priestesses and kings, and witness regal traditions that have survived the test of time. Don't miss this unique opportunity to glimpse into the vibrant culture and intricate history of West Africa.



YOUR ITINERARY

DAYS 1/2 ~ USA/LOMÉ, TOGO

HOTEL 2 FEVRIER. (Meals Aloft; No Meals)

Board your overnight flight to Lomé, Togo. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day will be at leisure.

DAY 3 ~ LOMÉ ~ FETISH MARKET HOTEL 2 FEVRIER (B,L,D)

Explore the vibrant capital of Togo, the only African town which has been colonized by the Germans, British, and French. Start in the central market with its famous "Nana Benz," women who control the market of the African fashion. You'll continue on to the colonial buildings in the administrative quarter and the largest Fetish Market on the continent, where an eclectic assortment of all the necessary ingredients for love potions and magical concoctions are sold. Return to your hotel where you will have some time to freshen up before dinner. Optional: in the evening, live music in town if available. A number of musicians in Togo are mixing songs in honor of the Divinities with energetic Afrofunk, as a consequence of the analogy between Voodoo drumming beats and blues, funk, as well as the rhythm and blues of James Brown, Otis Redding, Wilson Picket... and more!

DAY 4 ~ LOMÉ ~ VOODOO LAND HOTEL 2 FEVRIER (B,L,D)

Head to a remote hidden village to join a Voodoo ceremony: the frenetic rhythm of the drums and chants of the adepts help call in the Voodoo spirit who then takes possession of some of the dancers. In another village, visit a healer, a person who assists with complex issues by giving solutions based on assessing and treating the patient's spirit, and converse with him and some of his patients.

DAYS 5/6 ~ LOMÉ/AKOSOMBO, GHANA ROYAL SENCHI RESORT (B,L,D)

Cross the border into Ghana and continue to a charming village where you can enjoy a packed lunch and stretch your legs. In the afternoon, set sail on the serene waters of Lake Volta. As you glide along the calm waters, enjoy panoramic views of the landscapes dotted with traditional villages. Next day, explore the Krobo region, famous around the world for its beads. Here, delve into the intricacies of bead production at a specialized factory, witnessing firsthand the techniques that have been meticulously preserved and passed down through the generations of skilled craftsmen.

DAYS 7/8 ~ AKOSOMBO/KUMASI LANCASTER KUMASI CITY HOTEL (B,L,D Daily)

Drive to Kumasi, the historical and spiritual capital of the old Ashanti Kingdom, a sprawling city with a fantastic central market. Explore the Ashanti Cultural Centre: a rich collection of Ashanti artifacts housed in a reproduction of an Ashanti house. Participate – if available – in a traditional Ashanti

funeral, attended by mourners wearing beautiful red or black togas. If available, in the evening, you can attend live music in town. Next morning, head to the Royal Palace Museum, hosting a unique collection of gold jewels worn by the Ashanti court. Late morning, take part in the spectacular Akwasidae festival, experiencing a ceremony of ancient traditions, attended by the king and his court.

DAY 9 ~ KUMASI/ELMINA COCONUT GROVE HOTEL (B,L,D)

Drive to Elmina on the coast of Ghana, and visit castles and dungeons, relics of the ancient gold, ivory, and slave trades. Elmina is the oldest European building in sub-Saharan Africa and links the history of Africa to world history. Facing the castle and the ocean is a unique fishing harbor with hundreds of large, colorful canoes that every day defy the waves and currents. In the old town with its vivid atmosphere, discover the Posuban shrines of the "Asafo companies." These elaborate concrete shrines, decorated with fanciful statues, honor the great deeds of past warriors.

DAYS 10/11/12 ~ ELMINA/ACCRA/USA LABADI BEACH HOTEL (B,L,D; B,L, Meals Aloft)

Discover Kakum National Park, in the middle of a rainforest, close to the coast. Observe the forest from above on a canopy walk, the longest and highest rope bridge in the world. Then, head to Cape Coast Castle, a museum based on the history of slave trade. Visit Fort William, hosting a lighthouse. Then drive to Accra, the capital of Ghana, and enjoy the night at leisure. Next day, explore Jamestown's historic neighborhood, inhabited by the Ga people. Visit a workshop that specializes in Fantasy Coffins, unique handcrafted coffins built to reflect any shape: fruits, animals, fish, cars, airplanes, etc., the only limit being imagination! Later, transfer to the airport for your return flight back to the U.S.

PRE-EXTENSION TO BENIN



Embark on a journey to Cotonou, Benin. Delve into the serene beauty of Lake Nokoue and experience the unique charm of Ganvie, renowned as the largest stilt village across Africa. Immerse yourself in the vibrant world of contemporary African art at the Zinsou Foundation. Be captivated by the mesmerizing performances of Gelede & Egun mask dances in Ketou. Set out for Ouidah, the birthplace of Voodoo worship, and prepare for a display of Egun mask theater. Explore the rich heritage of Benin at the Abomey Royal Palace, a revered museum and UNESCO World Heritage site. Traverse the streets of Ouidah, visiting landmarks like the Python Temple and the elegant Villa Ajavon.

POST-EXTENSION TO MOLE NATIONAL PARK, GHANA



Enjoy the wild side of West Africa with a visit to Mole National Park, Ghana's largest wildlife refuge. These sprawling grasslands are home to over 93 mammal species, 33 species of reptiles, and 344 species of birds. Enjoy two guided safaris, early in the morning and late in the afternoon, when animals are more active, and look for elephants, hippos, buffalos, roans, oribi, and the predators that follow them: hyenas, lions and leopards. Search the waterways for the slender-snouted and dwarf crocodile, and the skies for martial eagle, Abyssinian roller, and violet turaco.

Main Program Accommodations

Hotel 2 Fevrier: Located in Lomé's main square, all rooms are equipped with modern amenities. The hotel has an outdoor pool and a gym.

Royal Senchi Resort: Facing the Volta River, this 4-star hotel has rooms that are fitted with a seating area, a flat-screen TV, and a private bathroom with free toiletries and a hot tub. Other amenities include an outdoor pool, a gym, and a spa.

Lancaster Kumasi City Hotel: Formerly known as The Golden Tulip, this hotel is located near the Kumasi central market. The property has a garden with a picnic area and sun terrace. Modern rooms provide free Wi-Fi, flat-screen TVs, minifridge, and a coffeemaker.

Coconut Grove Hotel: Located by the ocean in Elmina, this beach hotel features rooms with private bathrooms and complimentary toiletries. Other amenities include two outdoor tennis courts, a restaurant, and two bars/lounges.

Labadi Beach Hotel: Set amidst landscaped gardens, the hotel offers a modern spa, a well-equipped gym, a pool, a tennis court, and outdoor running space.
