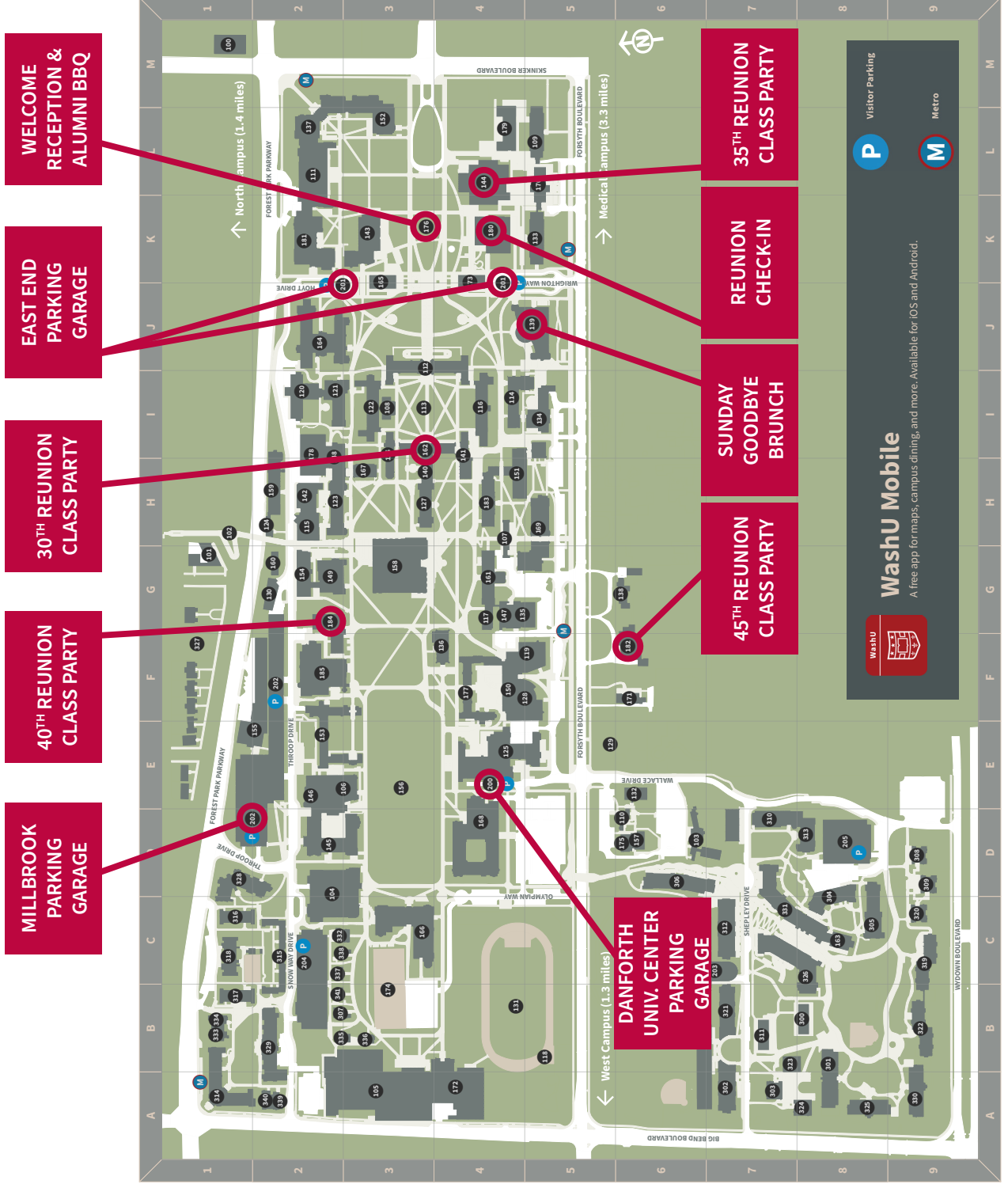

PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION

ON CAMPUS PARKING

Reunion attendees can park in the Danforth University Center (DUC), Millbrook, Snow Way, or East End garages. If parking on campus before 5 p.m. on Friday, you must park in a visitor space and pick up a parking validation at reunion check-in at Holmes Lounge (Friday 10 a.m.-3 p.m. or Weil Hall beginning at 5 p.m.)

If parking after 5 p.m. on Friday, guests can park in any visitor or yellow space throughout the weekend. A ticket must be pulled to enter a garage. The same ticket is inserted to exit the garage; however, you will not be charged upon exiting. Parking permits will be required again beginning Monday, April 22, at 7 a.m.
